Welcome to the 2022-2023 dance year at Donna's Dance Works!

I would like to welcome all of my new students and their families to our school and say welcome back to all of my students returning from last year and previous years!

***Rules and Guidelines-** Please be sure to know the rules and follow them accordingly. They are posted on the website. It is very important that you read them and know what is required for your child. Thanks

*** Registration** - the fee is \$20.00 per student (\$10.00 for 3rd child in family). Please pay this as soon as possible if you haven't already done so. Thanks!

***Monthly Payment-**will be according to the scheduled dates. There will also be reminders posted. There are 9 monthly payments due for the year. The 1st payment is due now. There will be a \$5.00 late fee for all payments that are made more than 14 days after the due date. All monthly payments must be paid regardless of absence. Payments can be made in the form of a check or cash. ALL PAYMENTS must be in an envelope with the child's name. Ask about discounts for cash payments.
(September payment will be considered on time until October 8.)

***Dance shoes** - All dancers must have their proper dance shoes by October 8. Everyone should be aware of what shoes your child is required to have. If you have any questions, please ask. I can order any shoes for you that you may need.
Order forms are available.

*** Dance Attire - everyone** must have the proper attire for each class.
Girls: Stockings or tights must be worn with a bodysuit, leotard, or unitard.
Nothing else is acceptable
Boys: No jeans or baggy pants. Pants must be tight at ankles.
Competitive classes have their own dress code.

***Newsletters-** you will receive a newsletter every month to inform you of everything you need to know. Please make sure that your child gives it to you. Ask for it, or check their bags. It always has some important information!! It will also be on the website

***Studio Fundraisers-** the first one is the Philly Sports Raffle. Tickets are \$20.00 each and your child will receive \$5.00 in credit for each ticket sold. Tickets are available now in packs of 10. Please email me with the quantity needed and I will send them home with your child or you can pick them up at the desk.
Ticket stubs and money are due on or before October 8.

***Competition Team Parent Meeting-** will be at the studio on Sunday, September 18 at 4:30 pm. One parent for each competition dancer is required to attend. If you cannot attend, it is your responsibility to get all information. We will be discussing EVERYTHING for this upcoming year!

***Used shoe bin-** is available for even exchanges only. You may also purchase a pair for a greatly discounted price. Shoes will no longer be given for free. After several issues last year, I have been forced to change the policy. Thank you for understanding.

***Outside drinks-** No outside drinks are permitted inside the building. No student is allowed to bring in a cup from Dunkin' Donuts, Starbucks, Wawa, etc. If your child has to have a special drink, it needs to be in their personal water bottle.. There were several incidents last year with spilling and way too much clean up. I will not allow any cups from any stores past the front door.

***School Holidays-** The days that the studio will be closed will be listed here each month. If the date is not in your newsletter, then we are open for classes. I don't always follow school holidays. Please check each month for days off!! Snow closings will be posted on the website DonnasDanceworks.com
